

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION - 3 DAYS:

Friday – the town of Nepomuk

Learn the story of Czech St. John of Nepomuk in the place of his birth, the town of Nepomuk. It was during the Baroque period when his following began to grow and the first churches and chapels in his name were built. Efforts for his canonization were successfully completed in 1729, when John was declared a saint. After John's canonization, the town of Nepomuk became a popular destination for many large processions. Therefore, a new larger church was bult by the renowned architect Kilian Ignac Diezenhofer.

Upon arrival in Nepomuk, you will be accommodated at the family hotel "U Zeleného stromu". After a three-course lunch, you will tour the town with a guide and visit the churches St. James and St. John of Nepomuk, enjoying an organ concert of Baroque music. You will also visit the Museum of St. John of Nepomuk. In the evening you can enjoy a buffet dinner, the screening of a film about the town of Nepomuk and live music in the Art Nouveau hall of the hotel.

Saturday - Plasy Monastery, Mariánská Týnice and the city of Pilsen

After breakfast you will transfer by bus to visit Plasy, a former convent founded in 1144, which was in the years 1661-1785 magnificently rebuilt in the Baroque style according to plans by Jean Baptiste Mathey, Jan Blazej Santini-Aichel and Kilian Ignac Dientzenhoffer. The monumental architecture of the convent above only compliments the perfectly mastered, unique water system construction below. Built atop swampland, foundations of the convent were reinforced by 5,100 oak piles driven into the ground. In 1785, the monastery was cancelled by the Emperor Joseph II. Since 1826, it became the residence of Chancellor Metternich and his family. And it was just here that he chose a place for his last resting and is still buried in the family tomb. After visiting the monastery, lunch at a renowned traditional restaurant will be served for you. Before returning to Pilsen, you will also see a former major pilgrimage site, Marianská Týnice, which was built in the 18th century also by Giovanni B. Santini.

In the afternoon, you will take a guided tour through the city center of Pilsen. You will learn all about the history of the royal city and Pilsner Urquell beer, which was born here in 1842. After the tour and check-in at the four-star hotel, you will have the opportunity to rest or enjoy more of the city centre yourself by taking a self-guided walk. In the evening an "All you can eat" three-hour dinner with unlimited consumption of Pilsner Urquell beer will take place in a well-known Pilsner restaurant.



MAGNIFICENT BAROQUE CULTURAL MONUMENTS OF THE PILSEN REGION (P17A)

Sunday - Kladruby monastery

After breakfast, you will depart for Kladruby and tour the former Benedictine monastery. The dominant feature of the complex is the Church of St. Mary of the Assumption, rebuilt by the famous Czech architect Jan Blazej Santini Aichel in the style of so-called Baroque-Gothic. The second largest building in the complex is the new convent of Kilian Ignac Dientzenhofer. Further, in the complex you will visit expositions of fragrances, scents and perfumes. You will be able to see and smell the essential ingredients of Oriental perfumery fragrances accented by sculptures of Matthias Bernard Braun placed in the lapidary in the hallway of the convent.
